

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT COLLECTIONS

- When : Place your bins on the edge of the road before 7 a.m. on collection day.
- In wintertime : Clear the snow and the ice from the bins. Make sure they do not impede snow clearing operations.
- How to place your bins : Bins must be placed with the handles and the wheels facing the road.

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COLLECTION (BLUE BIN)

ACCEPTED MATERIALS



- Clean paper and cardboard
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic bags
- Metal containers and packaging

- Rinse all containers to avoid bad odors.
- Place all materials together in the bin, except for shredded paper and plastic wraps that must be placed in a transparent plastic bag.
- Flatten the containers so they take up less space in the bin.

REFUSED MATERIALS

- Plastics without numbers or with number 6
- Paint containers
- Propane tanks
- Tools
- Flat glass, mirrors, bulbs, Pyrex
- Organic waste
- Clothes-line
- Clothes

Bins containing refused materials might not be collected.

COLLECTION OF HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE (GARBAGE BINS)

THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS SHOULD NOT BE FOUND IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE BIN:

- Recyclable materials
- Household hazardous waste (paints, oils, batteries, propane tanks, etc.)
- Construction materials
- Electronic products
- Tires and car batteries
- Green residues (fallen leaves, weeds, branches, etc.)
- Drugs and biomedical waste

- Etc.

YOU CAN DO MORE TO PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT

- Use reusable containers
- Give your things still in good condition to organizations or to people around you
- Do your own composting in a domestic bin
- Do not pick up your grass clippings or fallen leaves; instead, grasscycle by shredding them with the lawn mower!

ACCEPTED MATERIALS

Household hazardous waste (HHW)

Paints, aerosol cans, solvents, cleaning products, motor oils, antifreeze, compact fluorescent light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, batteries, propane tanks, toner cartridges, fire extinguishers, car batteries, etc.

Bulky waste

Maximum volume of 6 m³ per year, per building, including large objects, and of 2 m³ per trip. Bring your Ecocentre card!

Wood, concrete, asphalt shingles, bricks, stones, drywall, floor coverings, showers, bathtubs, sinks, toilets, ceramics, insulating materials, pieces of furniture, garden furniture.

Large objects

A large object is an article that weighs more than 25 kg or that cannot be carried in a car trunk, e.g. pieces of furniture, tables, couches, mattresses, box springs, beds, desks, bookcases. Maximum volume of 6 m³ per year, per building, including bulky wastes, and of 2 m³ per trip. Bring your Ecocentre card!

Metals

Barbecues, ranges, dishwashers, washers and dryers, small appliances, water heaters, objects made of metal, etc.

Electrical, electronic appliances, and computer equipment

Television sets, videos players, radios, computers, peripherals, cell phones, etc.

Branches

Leaves, pine needles, branches less than 12 cm in diameter, Christmas trees.

Household electrical appliances with halocarbons

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.

Tires without rims

Car tires of less than 83.82 cm; truck tires of less than 123.19 cm.

Clothes

REFUSED MATERIALS

- Drugs
- Animal carcasses
- Contaminated soil
- Explosives and weapons
- Asbestos
